This report contains student and school statistics for the 2004-2005 school year, including all four payment periods (September, November, February, and April).

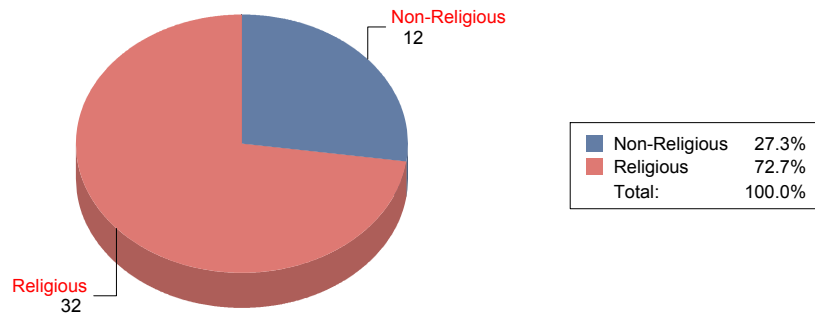

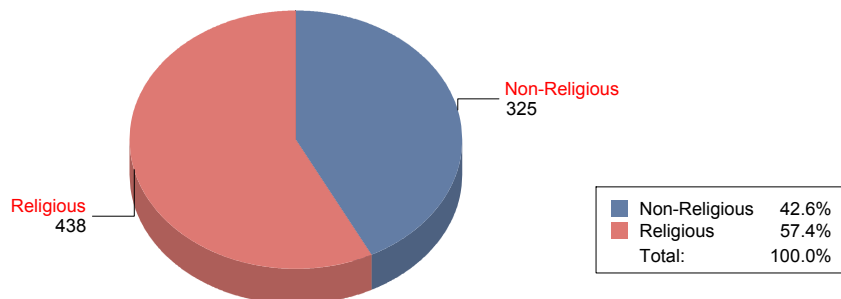

Private Schools Participating in OSP by Type

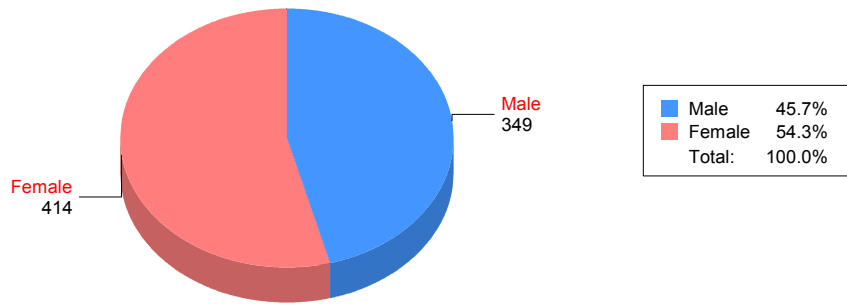


OSP Student Enrollment by Type of Schools



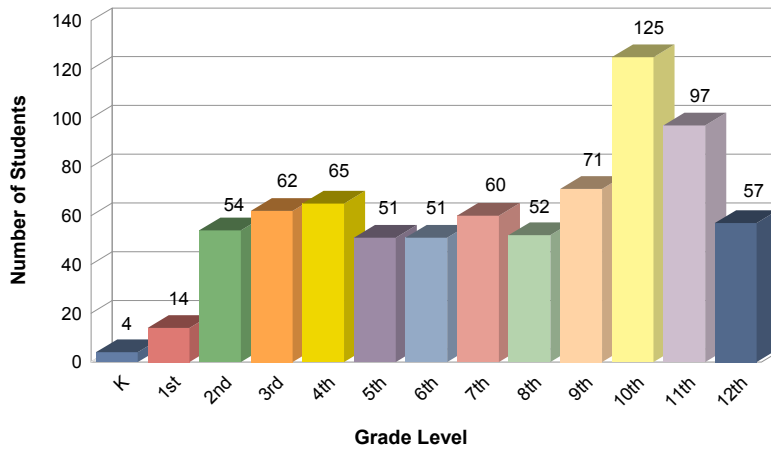

OSP Students Enrollment by Gender



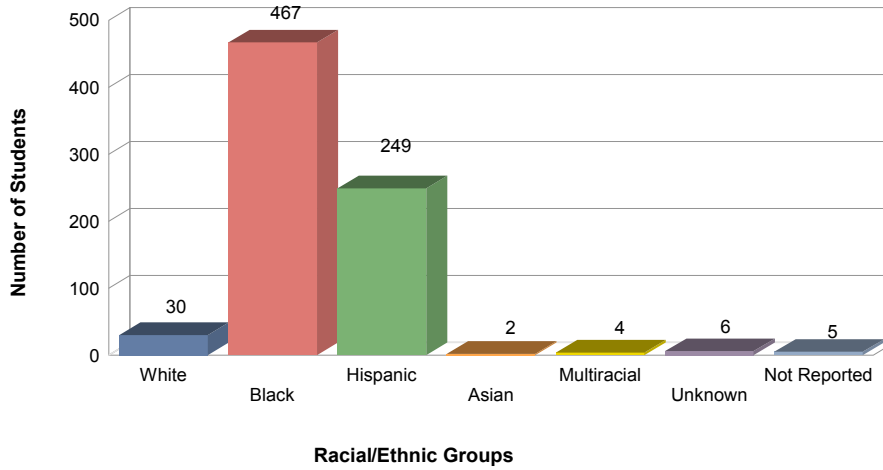

OSP Students Enrollment by Grade Level



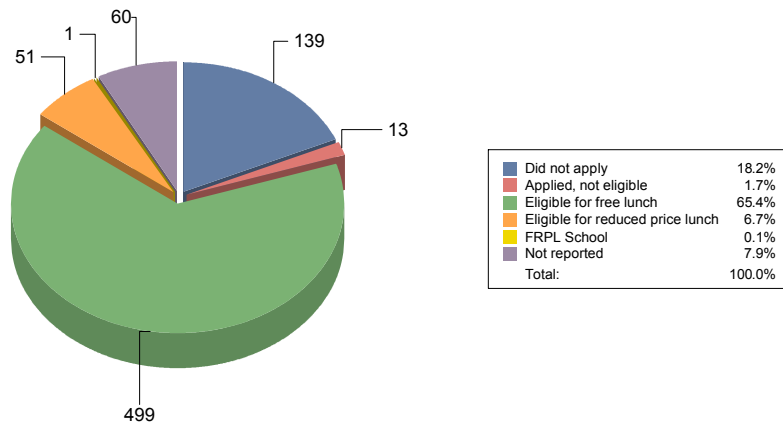
