This report contains student and school statistics for the September payment period of the 2005-2006 school year.

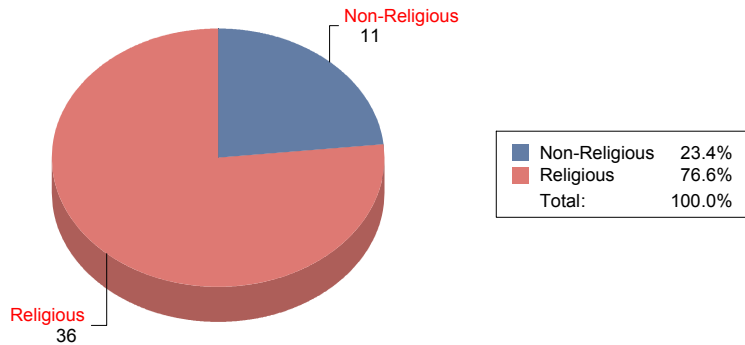

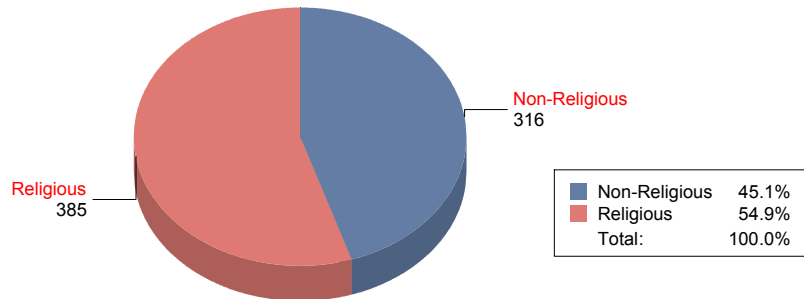

Private Schools Participating in OSP by Type

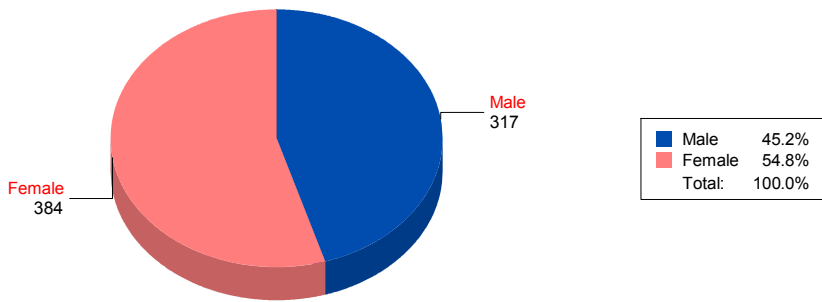


OSP Student Enrollment by Type of Schools



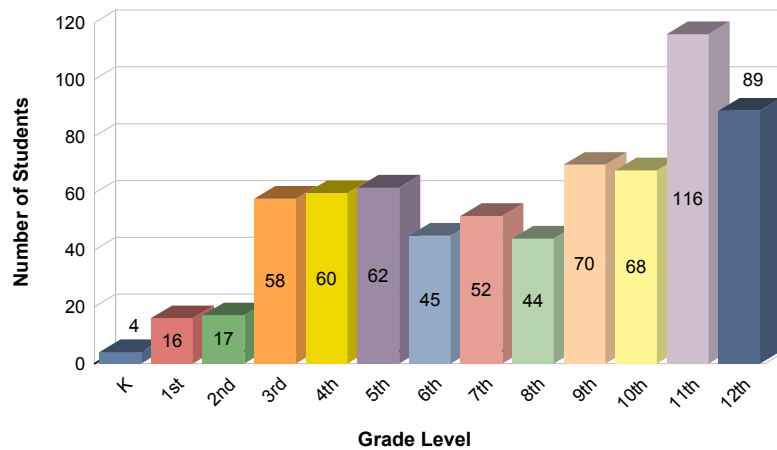

OSP Students Enrollment by Gender



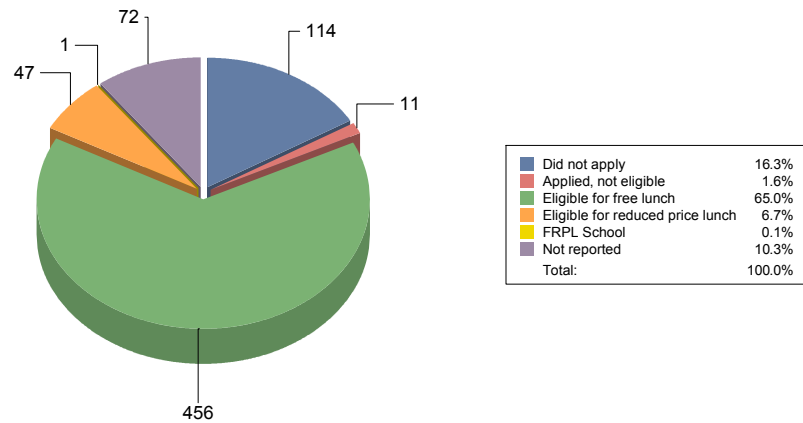

OSP Students Enrollment by Grade Level



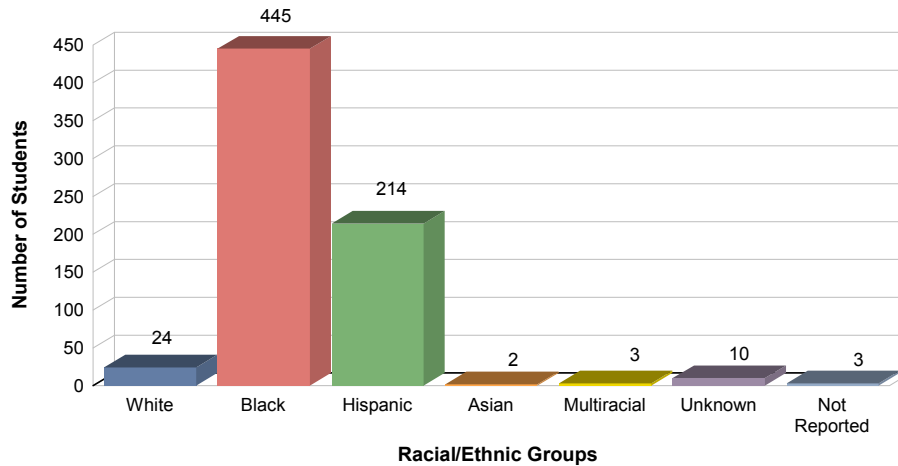
