# Private School Employee Fingerprinting

As private schools continue to resolve compliance related issues, it is important for both renewing schools and new participants to understand the employee fingerprinting requirements. Every employee or contracted personnel with direct student contact must electronically submit a set of fingerprints through the Florida De-



- Q. What about personnel who only participate in before- or after-school programs?
- **A.** A level 2 background screening is required only if <u>all</u> the answers to the questions below are Yes.
  - ☐ Is the person an employee or contracted personnel of the private school?
  - ☐ Does the person have unsupervised access to or direct contact with a scholarship student?
  - ☐ Is the private school responsible for the scholarship student?

partment of Law Enforcement (FDLE) for a state and national background screening. The screening results must be securely stored at the school's location and be available for inspection by the Department of Education should your school be selected for a site visit.

Please note that Department of Children and Families (DCF) background checks do not meet the statutory screening requirements for participation in the state scholarship programs because DCF does not provide the results to the private school for screening against <a href="mailto:s.435.04">s.435.04</a> and <a href="mailto:1012.315">1012.315</a>, F.S. Only teachers with a valid Florida teaching certificate are exempt per <a href="mailto:s.1002.421(2)(i)">s.1002.421(2)(i)</a>, F.S.

## FTC Norm-referenced Testing



This is a reminder to private schools participating in the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program to administer or make provisions for FTC students in grades 3-10 to take one of the nationally norm-referenced tests identified by

the Department of Education. The approved assessments and specific instructions are available on the School Choice Website at

www.floridaschoolchoice.org/Information/CTC/ norm\_referenced\_assessment.asp.

Participating private schools must make arrangements to administer one of the approved listed tests during the 2011-12 school year, unless the private school has requested and received approval to use an alternate assessment. If you have any questions related to this requirement, please contact your regional manager.

# McKay Payment Discrepancies

The third quarter McKay Scholarship payments for the 2011-12 school year were recently distributed. It is very important for participating private schools to review these payments immediately, as well as other payment records from throughout the school year.

Any discrepancies must be submitted to the Office of Independent Education and Parental Choice by March 5, 2012, for corrections to be reflected in the final payment of the school year that is scheduled for April 1. Any further payment correction requests for the current school year must be submitted to the Department no later than June 1, 2012 in order to receive payment.

**March 1**— Date by which Scholarship Compliance Form must be postmarked, after being submitted online, printed, signed and notarized.

March 2—Date by which students filing intent by February 1 must be enrolled to receive the April 1 payment.

**March 5-14**—Attendance Verification week for the final payment period.

**May 1**—Date by which all Compliance issues must be resolved.

**June 1**—Date by which requests for missing payments must be submitted.

**July 3**—Intent filing deadline for the September 1 payment.

**August 2**— Enrollment deadline for the September 1 payment.

**September 2**—Intent filing deadline to be eligible for the November 1 payment.

**October 2**—Enrollment deadline for the November 1 payment.

# **Compliance Renewal**

### 60 Days to Resolve Outstanding Issues

March 1st is the deadline for submission of the Compliance Form. On or before March 1st, the form must be:

- 1. submitted online,
- 2. printed, signed and notarized, and
- 3. mailed to the School Choice Office.

Compliance forms <u>must be postmarked</u> by the deadline to be eligible to participate in the Scholarships Program for the 2012-2013 school year.



May 1st is the deadline for resolving any outstanding issues. Following the timely submission of the Scholar-ship Compliance Form, renewing schools must resolve any outstanding compliance issues, including the submission of inspection reports and fiscal soundness documentation (if applicable), on or before May 1st. Schools unable to resolve compliance issues by May 1st will not be eligible to participate in the scholarship programs for the 2012-2013 school year.

Upon demonstration of compliance for the 2012-13 school year, the Department will send the private school a letter confirming compliance. If you have any questions related to your school's compliance status, please contact your regional manager.
