

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER


(Hurricane Wilma)


In accordance with the authority vested in me as State Coordinating Officer under Executive order 05-219, for private schools located within those districts which have been declared a federal disaster area, only to the extent necessitated by Hurricane Wilma's destruction, I authorize the following:

The requirement of Rule 6A-1.09512, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), requiring a minimum school term of 170 actual school days for private schools, is waived as set forth below to the extent affected private schools were unable to open on their normal schedule or lost school days as a result of Hurricane Wilma and do not have extra days in their schedule that could constitute make-up days.

1. Each potentially affected private school may consider as waived the same number of days granted to the public school district in which they are located.
2. Any private school taking advantage of a waiver must still meet the hourly equivalent requirements for net instructional hours as prescribed by Rule 6A-1.09512(2), F.A.C.
3. Private schools using a waiver shall provide a revised annual survey to the Department of Education pursuant to s.1002.42, Florida Statutes, indicating the number of days school will be in session.
