Technical Requirements for all Advertisements:

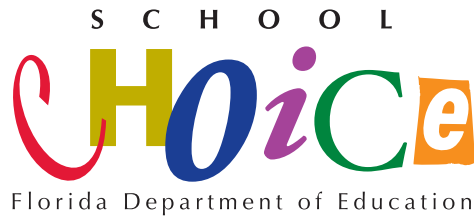
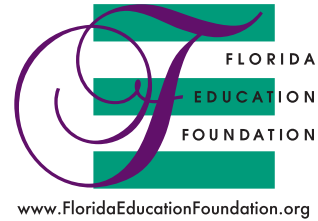
- Advertisements must be sent print-ready/camera-ready, with all registration and bleed marks included

- Send ad in .eps, .tif (300 dpi), or Press Quality High Resolution PDF format
- Make sure all text is converted to paths (Create Outlines for InDesign Users)
