District Verification Deadlines for 2013-2014

District enrollment verification of students to be funded through the McKay Scholarship is an important accountability safeguard built into the program to ensure funding is appropriately distributed. The chart below displays the verification dates for the 2013-14 school year. For each payment period, the McKay student file will be available to districts via the Northwest Regional Data Center (NWRDC) site on the date listed for district review and verification, and must be submitted by the deadline in red. Once payments have been issued, the NWRDC will post the list of paid students.

District Verification File: McKay pre-payment file which is exported to districts to verify students are not enrolled in public school system. This file contains all students the DOE *intends* on paying.

District FTE File: McKay post-payment file which identifies the students **who were** paid for the specified payment period and who will need to be reported to generate FTE funding.

Reminders

April

- Parents must file intent to participate in the McKay Scholarship by July 3 in order to receive the first quarterly payment.
- Participating schools must register and enroll McKay students by August 2 in order to receive the first quarterly payment.
- Districts should ensure that McKay students matriculating from elementary to middle, or from middle to high school are not automatically re-enrolled in the district.

Establishing McKay Eligibility in Pre-K

The McKay Scholarship may be awarded to eligible students beginning in their kindergarten year, and a student may now establish eligibility for the program in pre-kindergarten in one of two ways. Previous to the 2012-13 school year, eligibility could only be established by being enrolled and reported by a Florida school district for funding during the preceding October and February FTE surveys. Beginning in 2012-13, students may establish eligibility for the McKay Scholarship in the pre-kindergarten year by participating in the Specialized Instructional Services (SIS) program, which is administrated through the Office of Early Learning (OEL).

Our office will receive attendance data from OEL about participating SIS students, and parents of these students will be able to file intent through our website at www.floridaschoolchoice.org. Our district McKay contacts will then see these students in their McKay Student List, and "SIS Program" will be listed as the last public school attended. The attendance portion of eligibility will have already been confirmed by OEL, and the district ESE office will be required to create a kindergarten IEP and matrix of services to facilitate McKay Scholarship Program participation.
