Scholarship Compliance Renewal

Private schools participating in the state scholarship programs must renew their participation annually by submitting verification of their compliance with program requirements. The **2016-17 Scholarship Compliance Form** was posted on the School Choice website on **November 1st**. The Scholarship Compliance Form must be submitted online and also printed, signed, notarized and postmarked no later than **March 1**, **2016**. Any outstanding issues must be resolved on or before May 1st in order for the school to remain eligible to participate in the state scholarship programs for the next school year.

January 2

Date by which new students with a valid intent must be enrolled to receive the February 1st payment.

January 4-8

Attendance Verification week for the third payment period.

February 1

Last day to file an intent to participate for the 2015-16 school year.

February 2

First day for new students to file an intent for the 2016-17 school year.

March 2

Date by which a new student must be enrolled to receive the fourth quarterly payment.

March 3-10

Attendance Verification week for the final payment period.

Child Abuse Training for Teachers

Florida school personnel have a duty to report actual or suspected cases of child abuse, abandonment or neglect. Reporting can be done by phone, fax or online. The Department of Children and Families, Florida Abuse Hotline and Child Care Regulation has developed additional training on this topic. The web-based course, specifically designed for teachers in grades 1-12, is titled Identifying and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect.
